Golf Course Superintendent-Twin Hills Golf & Country Club Oklahoma City Area

The Superintendent is responsible for the maintenance, operation, and management of the golf course. The Superintendent's operating functions will include:

- Turfgrass, greens, and plant maintenance
- Property/asset management
- Maintenance and repair of construction and golf course maintenance equipment
- Forecasting and expense management
- Scheduling and maintenance of irrigation system
- Supervise chemical applications compliant with all regulatory mandates
- Direct and supervise crews
- Attend meetings as directed by management
- Become familiar with Club operations, maintenance and golf activities
- Supervise the safe use of mechanical equipment
- Oklahoma pesticide applicator's license required or obtained within 90 days
- Ensure staff is working within OSHA, Club safety, state, and federal guidelines for safe working conditions. Provide technical, operational, and safety training for employees as directed.
- Ability to work well under pressure, coordinating multiple tasks at any time
- Attention to detail a must and be able to communicate with staff, members, guests

Because of the fluctuating demands of the Clubs operations, it may be necessary that each employee perform a multitude of different functions; therefore, as an essential part of your job, you will be expected to help others when the occasion arises just as other employees are expected to help you.

The Superintendent will report directly to the General Manager.
